PRODUCT ADVICE SHEET

MATT EMULSION

Alix Lawson Matt Emulsion is a water based decorative paint with high opacity and a low VOC level. It is EN71-3 certified which means it is completely safe for children's rooms.

PROPERTIES

USES: for interior walls and ceilings

SIZES: available in 100ml sample pot and 2.5l

COLOURS: all 5 white shades

COVERAGE: One litre will cover approx. 15m² (depending on the properties of the surface, the colour being used and method of application)

SURFACE DRY: depending on room temperature and humidity, the paint will normally be touch dry after 30-60 mins. The surface can be re-coated after 2 hours

RECOMMENDED COATS: 2

SURFACE PREPARATION

EXISTING PAINT FINISH: remove all loose and flaking paintwork. Degrease with a suitable detergent solution, such as sugar soap, followed by a clean water rinse. Rub down thoroughly with a medium grade sand paper to provide a key and a defect free smooth surface, 'feathering in' areas where paint has been removed. Make good any repairs, sand and apply primer to exposed surface as appropriate. High sheen paint surfaces should be thoroughly sanded to provide a key, or use an all surface primer prior to painting.

EXISTING PLASTER WALLS: lightly wash any existing paint work to remove any dust or surface laitance. Apply a primer coat by thinning with a 5% to 15% (v/v) addition of clean water, depending upon the porosity of the substrate. Finish by applying at least one full coat, as required.

NEW PLASTER WALLS: for plaster skim, allow at least four weeks for the plaster to thoroughly dry. Apply a primer coat by thinning the paint with a 15% to 25% (v/v) addition of clean water, depending upon the porosity of the substrate. Cut in by brushing at the same dilution recommendation as for priming, to promote flow and sealing of the substrate. Finish by applying two full coats. For new, fully plastered walls, allow at least six months for the plaster to thoroughly dry before painting.

APPLICATION

Stir well before use. Apply in temperatures above 8°C. Apply using a good quality brush or roller. New brushes should be conditioned by washing in clean water and thoroughly drying with a clean, lint free, cloth. Avoid immersing brush too far into the paint to prevent paint from entering the ferrule. Avoid drips and splashes by not overloading the brush. Apply paint in even strokes and only extend painting area such that a wet edge can be easily maintained. For the highest quality appearance, apply final brush strokes in the same direction and never go over paint that has already begun to dry. Use soapy water for cleaning the tools.

If using a spray canister, the paint may need thinning with water. If using a compliant spray gun use a 1.8-2.2 tip with maximum pressure of 30psi water the paint down by max 15%. If using an airless spray gun – 9000-11,000 tip size with a 50-degree angle. 5% water to thin.

If using more than one tin of paint, check the batch numbers to see if they are the same. If they are not, mix the tins together and stir thoroughly before use. This will avoid colour variations and will ensure an even colour throughout your home.

STORAGE

Store containers tightly sealed in a cool but frost free place. Shelf life: 24 months in original sealed container from date of purchase. Paint should be stored between 8-25°C.

DISPOSAL
